Happy New Year! I hope you have all had a restful break. It has been wonderful seeing the children back in school and hearing about their Christmas holidays. We have already been busy starting new learning this term.

In English we are starting off the year by reading **'Lost and Found'** by Oliver Jeffers. In maths we will be focusing on numbers to 20, addition and subtraction within 20, and some measurement work too. This term, we will be focusing on two topics. The first topic is **'Toys'**, where we will investigate toys from the past and present, and discuss similarities and differences between them. In our second half term we start a new topic of **'Weather in the UK'**, a geography topic looking at the four countries of the UK, compass directions, and investigating weather patterns with field work. Trip to the Science Museum: Tuesday 11th February

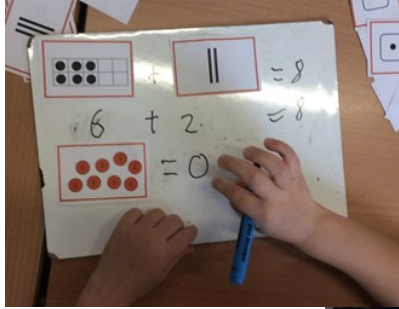
