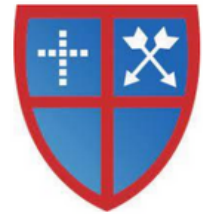

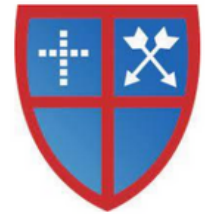

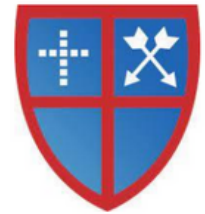

YEAR 1

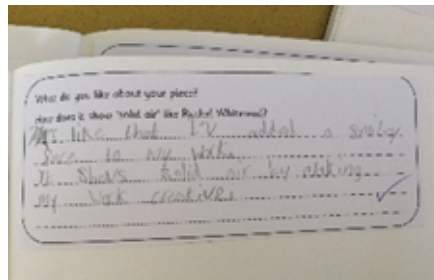

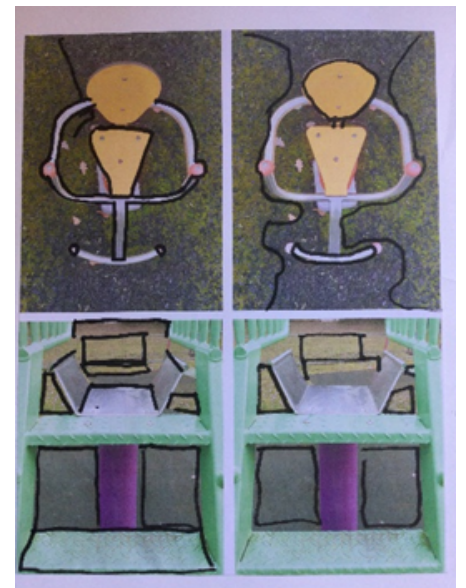
YEAR 2

Year 2 studied the artist Rachel Whiteread, looking at her clay tiles. They then designed, created and evaluated their own clay tiles!



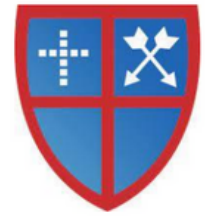
YEAR 3

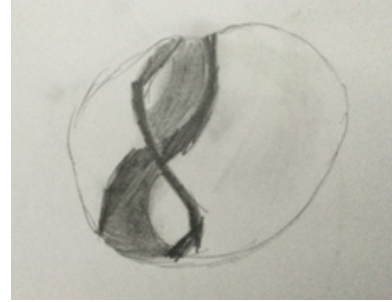
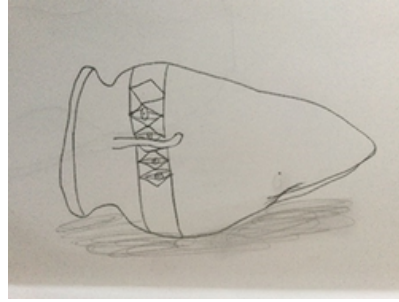


ART WEEK

Year 4 studied the artist Barbara Hepworth. They designed and carved soap sculptures.



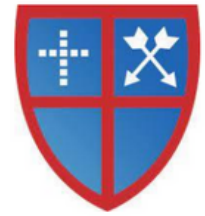
YEAR 5

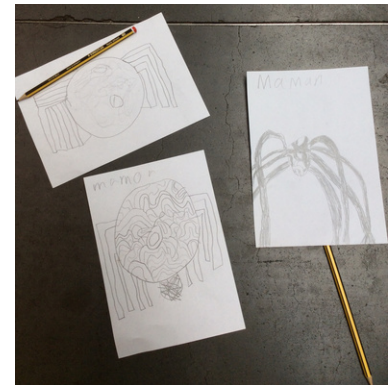


OUR ENRICHED CURRICULUM

They enjoyed sketching the huge sculpture in the turbine hall. It was certainly much bigger than the one they made in class!

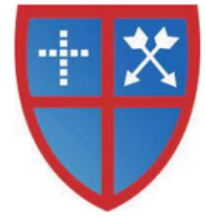


EYFS Natural History Museum

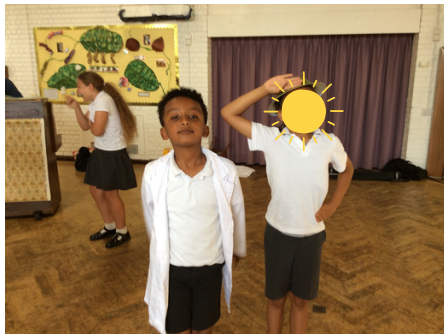

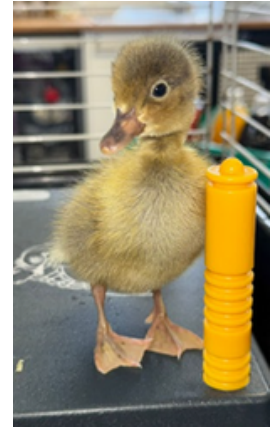
