Workshares

Our class workshare will take place during the second Autumn Term. The exact dates and times will be confirmed via email closer to the event.

Homework

Homework will be handed out on **Fridays** and should be returned by the following **Wednesday morning** at the latest. We ask that children read every evening for **5–10 minutes (or longer, if possible)** to build fluency and focus. This can include children reading independently or being read to. Please make a note of the pages your child has read. Reading at home does not always need to be from school books—we also encourage children to enjoy appropriately challenging chapter books and other suitable reading materials. Reading records will be checked regularly.

P.E.

Our P.E. lessons are on **Mondays and Wednesdays**. Children should bring their PE kit to school and will get changed before the lesson.
