We will support children in re-applying sunscreen before they go outside to play. This is also an important part of their Personal, Social and Emotional Development, under the goal of 'Managing Self'.



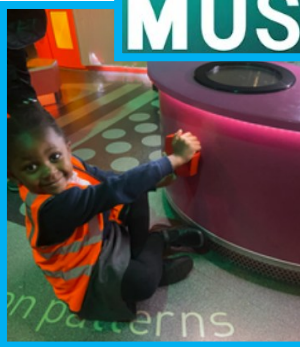
