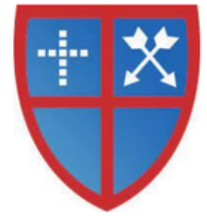


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HEADTEACHERS MESSAGE

Congratulations, Miss Morgado, on this well-deserved success!



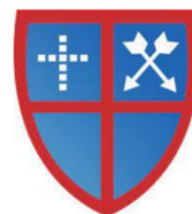

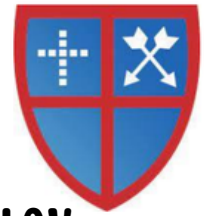

"My favourite thing about Reception was making some good friends and watching the ducklings hatch. - Alys, Reception

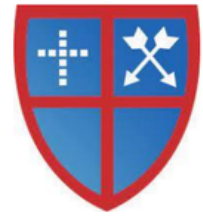

We hope you can join us and look forward to seeing you there.

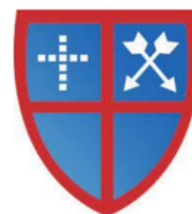
