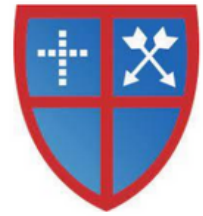

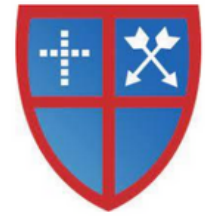

Year 3 students visited Shree Ghanapathy Temple, exploring cultural diversity and learning about Hindu traditions. We proudly support all faiths at Macaulay



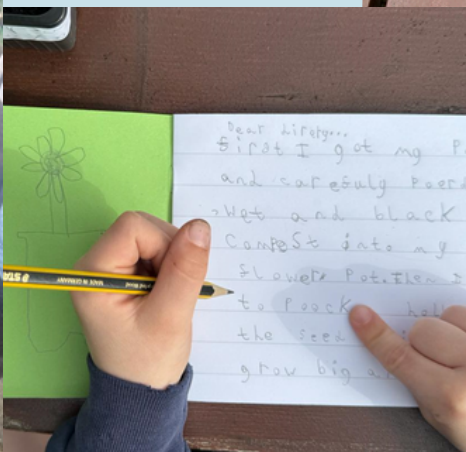

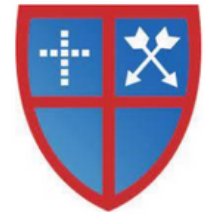

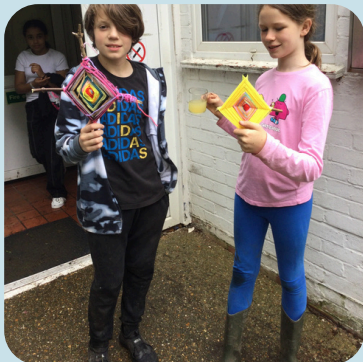

Year 6 celebrated the end of SATs with an adventurous trip to Go Ape and a fun-filled camping experience at the Scouts Centre in Dulwich.



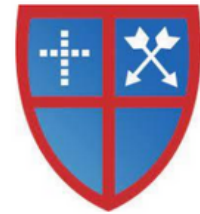

CYCLE CONFIDENT

Cycle Confident, Lambeth's cycle training provider, are running free cycle training courses on Clapham Common in the half term holiday (Tues - Fri). There will be Learn-to-Ride courses in the mornings and 1 on-road course across the 4 afternoons for children aged 9+ who are confident riders. In total this represents 16 Learn-to-Ride places and 8 On-Road places during the holiday and these are bookable on a first-come-first-served basis. Bikes are available to borrow for those who need one.
